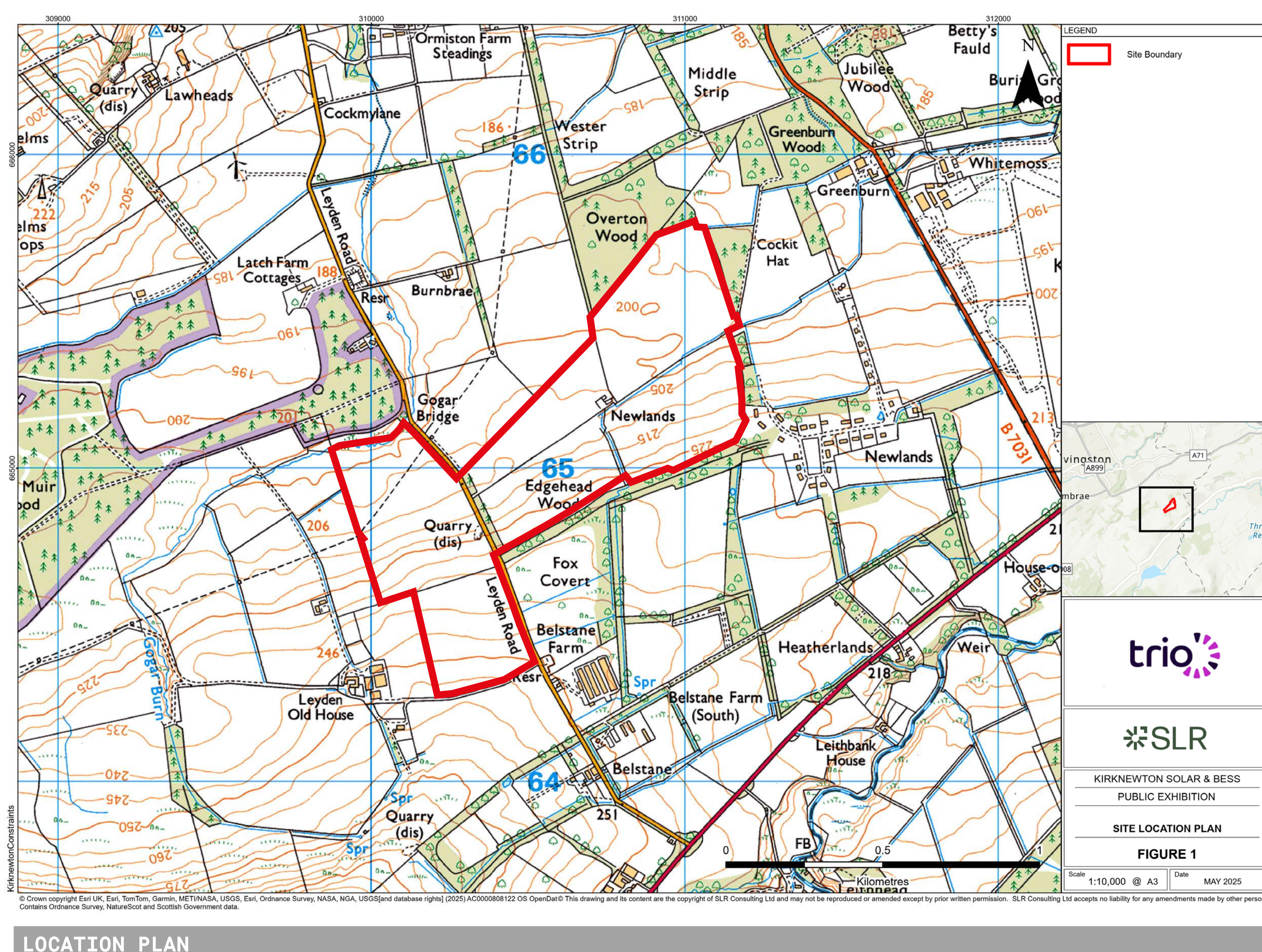

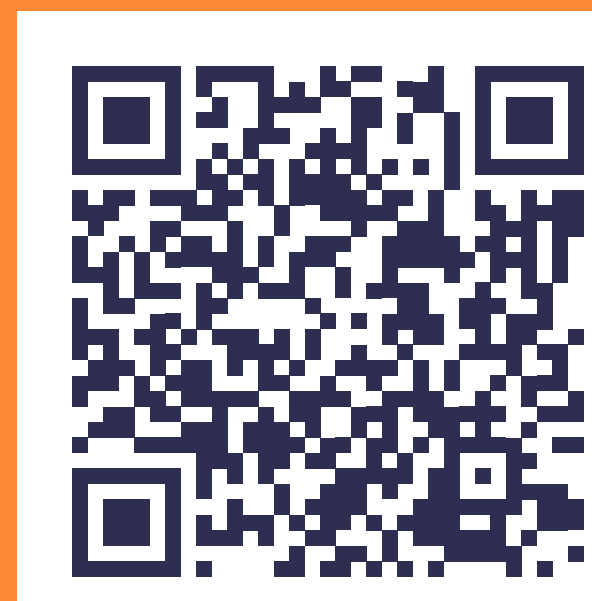


Kirknewton Solar and BESS Farm is being developed by BLC Energy, a Perthshire-based Scottish renewable energy developer. TRIO Power Limited owns the project. TRIO Power is owned and funded by the Octopus Renewable Infrastructure Trust (ORIT), a fund managed by Octopus Energy Generation (OEGEN) and part of the Octopus Energy Group. OEGEN is one of Europe's largest renewable energy investors, managing more than 230 large-scale green energy projects with a combined capacity of 3.25GW.
