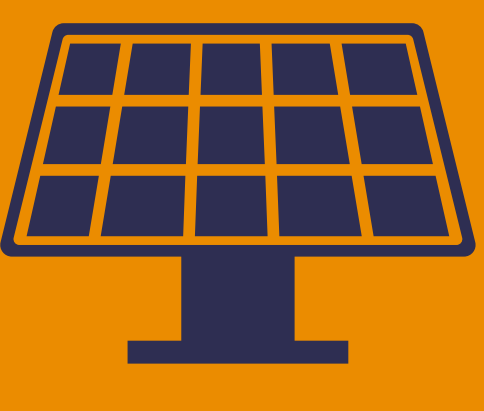


Welcome

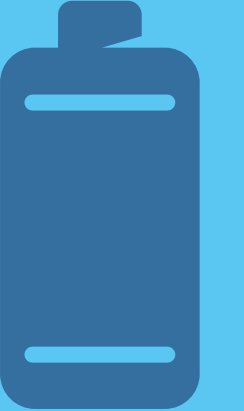

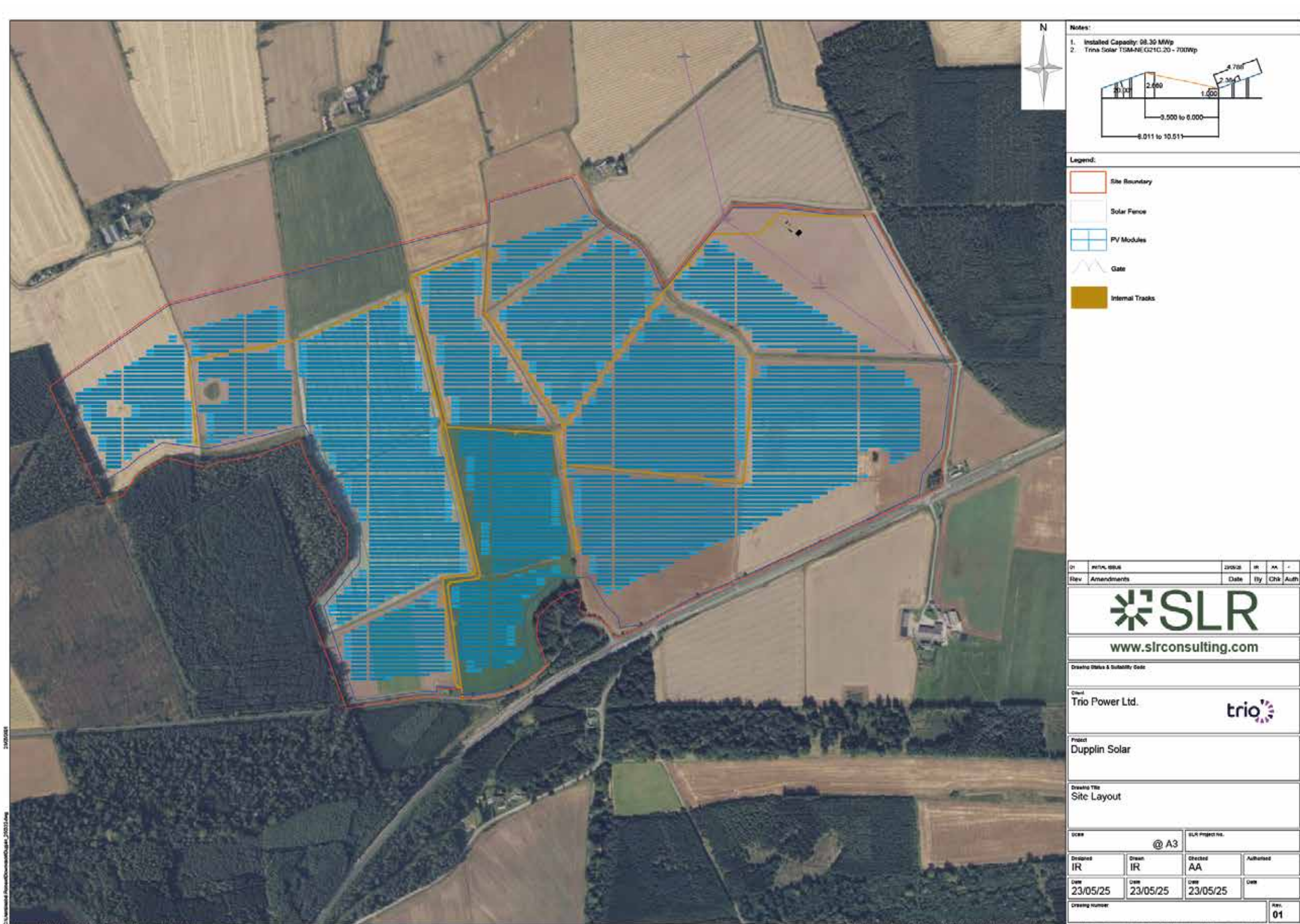

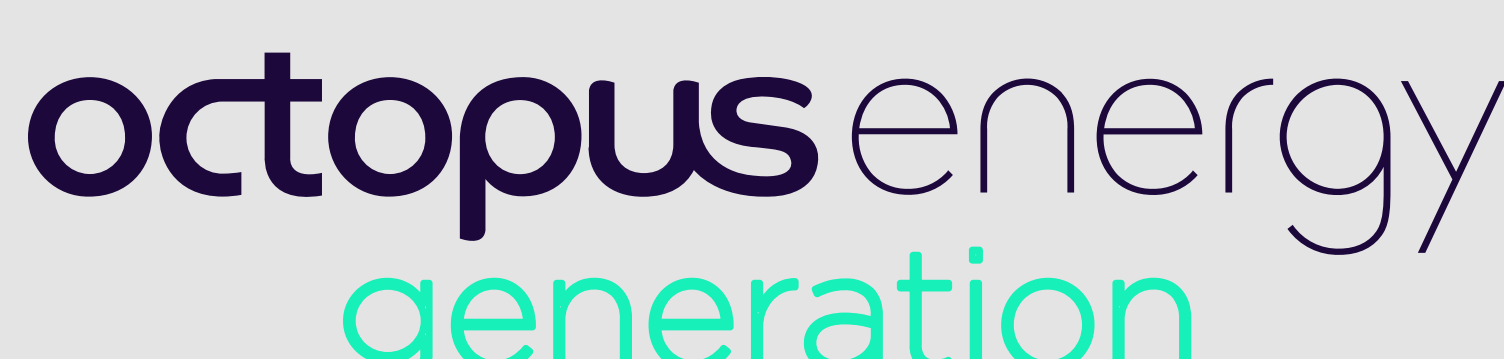
