Dupplin Solar Project Survey Responses

We would like to thank everyone who took the time to take part in our recent community survey about the proposed Dupplin Solar Farm. Your feedback is very important to us, and we appreciate residents sharing their views.

The survey was carried out in January 2026 and was open to residents living within 2km of the proposed Dupplin Solar Farm site. In total, 37 responses were received from local residents. Most responses were gathered through door-to-door conversations with residents, with a small number replying after the survey. Results of the public survey will be included in the published planning application document which will be available online and in Perth and Crieff public libraries.

The purpose of the survey was to hear directly from people living nearby about their thoughts, questions, and any concerns regarding the project. The attached document provides an outline of the key questions and topics raised during the survey, along with responses provided by BLC Energy.

We are very grateful to everyone who welcomed representatives from Taylor McKenzie's at their door or took the time to complete the survey. Community input is an important part of the process, and your views help ensure local voices are heard.

As mentioned in our previous letter, if this project is built, we, together with Octopus Renewable Infrastructure Trust (ORIT, part of the Octopus Energy Group) would like to explore the potential in rolling out a Local Energy Discount Scheme so that households nearby such as yours can get some benefit directly from the project.

This initiative aligns with the Scottish Governments aspirations of seeing neighbouring communities gain direct benefits from projects such as these. ORIT already operates a scheme like this at one of its other projects in Scotland. The concept is straight forward, households register for the scheme and get a discount directly on their energy bills.
